He's followed by five piece jazz combo Le Jazz Accord and for classical fans there's also entertainment from the Mariposa String Quartet. Once again some of Guernsey's well-known performers and rising stars will perform in the Arts Commission Showcase and we are delighted to welcome back Guernsey's legendary sea-shanty group GU10. There's lots of other entertainment to discover as you wander around the grounds of the Castle.

Friday 28th July 6pm-9pm The Crowman is our welcome act for week three of KPMG Castle Nights and is sure to get the evening off to a rousing start. There's a set from guitarist John Byrne playing his unique mix of classical, Spanish and popular music, followed by the Guernsey Jazz Orchestra. Local band Kismet Bleu make their Castle Nights debut with a mixture of jazz, blues and soul and one of Guernsey's longest established bands The Bandits take to the stage with a great blend of rock and pop. Add to all of this another musical showcase from the Arts Commission and you have the perfect KPMG Castle Night.
